Some Areas Josh Discussed

1. Rebates for energy efficiency
2. Newest lighting technology
3. Heating to include thermostat usage
4. Set Thermostat at 68 degrees maximizes comfort & efficiency
5. Replace weather stripping
6. Caulk around windows
7. Set your water heater thermostat no higher than 120 degrees
8. Replace your shower head with a water efficient shower head
9. Turn off lights when not in use
10. Check the Chelan County PUD's website for more tips.
